## **4. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES.**

4.1) Students seeking admission shall apply online only. Online Registration facility for admission is provided through [www.sdeuoc.ac.in](http://www.sdeuoc.ac.in)>[OnlineRegistration](#) . The printout of the application along with all required documents should be sent to : **The Director, School of Distance Education, University of Calicut, Calicut University.P.O, Malappuram-673635.**

### **4.2) Procedure for submitting online application**

- Login to the website of the School of Distance Education [www.sdeuoc.ac.in](http://www.sdeuoc.ac.in).
- Go to Online Registration and select the appropriate link.
- If you are a new user, click the **SIGN UP** button where you will be asked to enter the following details
  - a) AADHAAR Number / PAN Number/ Voter ID Card Number
  - b) E-mail ID
  - c) Mobile Number (*Note : Please enter your own valid mobile number . This number will be used for all future correspondence and cannot be changed later.*)
- After successful completion of registration, go to your registration link and **SIGN IN** using your E-mail ID and Mobile Number .
- Select the Course (please note that the course once selected cannot be modified/changed later), and fill in your personal details. Personal details can be modified until you make the final submission. Address for communication should be entered carefully.
- Upload your Passport size photograph in JPEG format (in specified size) and upload the documents in PDF format (in specified size) and click **SUBMIT** Button.
- Then you will be redirected to the Payment page where your payment details will be displayed. (Please note that the payment is completely online. **Offline mode of payment will not be entertained in any case**).
- After the successful submission, take a print out of the application. The photograph of the candidate in the print out of the application should be attested by a Gazetted Officer.
- The print out of the application along with all the required documents should be sent to the **Director, School of Distance Education, University of Calicut, Calicut University.P.O., Malappuram-673635** before the last date specified.

Admission is granted only on satisfactory fulfillment of the eligibility conditions regarding basic qualifications and the submission of relevant documents prescribed in the prospectus. ***Applications without the required documents shall be summarily rejected. The printout of the applications will not be accepted after the last date specified in the notification.***

#### **4.3) Additional PG Degree**

There is provision for registering for Additional PG Degree Programmes. Additional PG Degree candidates should submit the self attested copy of the previous PG Degree / Provisional Certificate in addition to the other necessary documents. Additional PG Degree candidates will not be eligible for any mark relaxation and fee concession.

#### **4.4) Identity Card**

Student admitted to the School of Distance Education will be issued with an Identity Card showing the **Enrollment Number, Contact Class Centre** etc . This can be downloaded from the website ([www.sdeuoc.ac.in](http://www.sdeuoc.ac.in)>**online identity card**) . Identity Card is mandatory for entry to the School of Distance Education and to attend Contact Classes. If the original Identity Card is lost or damaged, a duplicate will be issued online on payment of prescribed fee for duplicate Identity Card . Students must quote their **Enrollment Number** in all their correspondence with SDE.

#### **4.5) Contact Classes**

The students of SDE will be offered contact classes online through various platforms/ and offline mode at various Learner Support Centres (Contact Class Centres). Offline classes will be conducted if the situation is conducive for conduct of such classes. The details regarding these centres are given in the table in Sl.No.5. Students can choose a Learner Support Centre (Contact Class Centre) at the time of Online Registration. The allotment of such centres will depend on the number of students enrolled for each programme. If sufficient number of candidates are not enrolled for a programme, the nearest contact class centre will be allotted or the contact classes will be held in the Head Quarter of the School of Distance Education. The time table of contact classes will be uploaded in the website in advance. The classes will be handled by teachers of the SDE, teachers of the colleges affiliated to the Universities in Kerala and by experts in the field concerned.



#### **4.6) Study Materials**

The study materials prepared by the teachers / experts in the subject will be issued to the students. The soft copies of the study materials will be made available in the website([www.sdeuoc.ac.in](http://www.sdeuoc.ac.in)>Student Zone>Study Materials).

#### **4.7) University Examinations**

The examinations of the School of Distance Education will be conducted by the Examination Branch, University of Calicut. Students of the School of Distance Education should submit their applications for Examination online as per the notification issued by the Controller of Examinations, University of Calicut from time to time. The time table of examinations will be notified in News Papers and in the University website([www.uoc.ac.in](http://www.uoc.ac.in)) . The students who fail to remit their tuition fee on time will not be permitted to apply for examinations.

#### **4.8) Centres of Examination**

The students can select their preferred examination centre from the list of approved centres provided at the time of examination registration. Centre once selected cannot be changed. The final allotment of examination centre will depend on the number of students that can be accommodated to each centre.

#### **4.9) Transfer Certificate**

Original Transfer Certificates, submitted by the students seeking admission to the postgraduate programme, will not be returned to them once they are admitted to the programme. A fresh TC will be issued by the SDE after completion of the course or on discontinuation / cancellation of the course.

#### **4.10) Parity with Regular Students**

Students of the SDE are offered the same Courses as in the regular colleges affiliated to the University of Calicut. They have the same syllabi, curriculum and examinations.

**4.11) SDE Library** :The SDE has a separate Library of its own with a good collection of books, periodicals, Newspapers, reference books etc. Students can make use of the library resources and the reference services on all working days producing their Identity card .

**4.12) Students' Grievance Redressal Committee (SGRC):** Exclusively for receiving the grievances of SDE students, a Students' Grievance Redressal Committee (SGRC) has been launched with a view to solve the problems faced by students. ## **6. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO PG PROGRAMMES**

### **6.1 General Rules:**

1. Candidates who have passed the qualifying examinations at an annual/semester examination or its preceding supplementary examinations held by the examination authorities alone are eligible to seek admission to any PG programme of study under the University.
2. The interval between the date of passing the qualifying exam and the exam for which admission is sought should not be less than the normal period prescribed for the programme of study.
3. Children of service persons who are awarded gallantry decorations in the Vir Chakra either in person or posthumously and also on Non-Decorated service Personnel who are killed in action will be exempted from the requirement of minimum marks prescribed for admission to M.A/M.Com/M.Sc. Programmes. (GA/G2/28074/1984 dated 01.12.1986).
4. **Triple main candidates are also eligible for admission. However, they have to submit a copy of the Recognition Certificate from the University of Calicut.**

### **6.2 Equivalency / Recognition**

1. Equivalency/Recognition of the qualifying examinations taken from other Universities/Institutions should be confirmed strictly before making the online registration.

### **6.3 Relaxation in minimum marks to Backward Communities**

1. Candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribes who have secured minimum pass in the qualifying examination are eligible for admission to higher programmes/courses in this University. (U.O.No. GA I/B1/36/1992 dated 08.10.1192)
2. Other Backward Communities will be allowed a concession of 5% in the minimum marks required for admission to all PG programmes (U.O.No. GA I/A2/9091/1994 Vol.II dated 26.07.2003)
3. Other Eligible Communities are also eligible for relaxation of 5% in the minimum marks for admission to various programmes/courses of study. (GA/G2/2566/1986 dated 16.03.1987) .
4. Additional PG candidates will not be eligible for any mark relaxation.

OBC/OEC candidates are eligible for relaxation

7. M.Com up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.  
Any candidate who has passed B.Com or BBA (earlier BBS) degree of University of Calicut or recognized# B.Com, BBA, BBM or BBS degree of any other University or Institutes in any states, with minimum of 45% aggregate marks or equivalent overall CGPA is eligible for admission to the M.Com programme. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible for relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need to get a pass.  
In case of B.Com(Honours) and B.Com(Professional) and BBA(Honours), the minimum eligibility for admission is a minimum of 50% aggregate marks or equivalent overall CGPA , for all categories of students.
8. Msc. Mathematics B.Sc. Degree in Mathematics of this University or an equivalent\* degree, with at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA in Main (Core) and at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA in Part III (Core and Complementary put together).  
  
In the case of those students having a B.Sc. degree or B.Sc. Honours degree (without complementary/subsidiary papers) equivalent\* to the B.Sc. Mathematics Degree of the Calicut University, they only need to secure at least 50% marks in the main (core) and electives put together (if there is/are any elective paper/papers). OBC/OEC candidates are eligible for a relaxation of up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

\* For the purpose of confirming the eligibility, students from other Universities have to mandatorily submit an equivalency certificate obtained from the University of Calicut.

# For the purpose of confirming the eligibility, students from other Universities have to mandatorily submit a Recognition certificate obtained from the University of Calicut.

### **8.1) Fee Concession**

(a) Students belonging to SC/ST/OEC category are exempted from remitting the Tuition Fee only if (1) they are not employed in Govt/Quasi Govt/Public sector services (2) not seeking admission for additional PG degree (3) fee concession not availed previously at Post Graduate Level either through the University or through Block Panchayath concerned. But they have to remit all other special fee like Admission Fee, Matriculation Fee etc. To avail the fee concession, such students have to submit the duly filled in application for fee concession(available in the website : [www.sdeuoc.ac.in](http://www.sdeuoc.ac.in)>Downloads>Application forms) along with the self attested copies of SSLC Certificate, +2 Certificate, Degree consolidated Grade Card, Degree Provisional Certificate, AADHAAR and certificates to prove Caste / Community, Nativity and Income issued by competent authorities **at the time of admission**. In addition to the above, a certificate

issued from the office of the SC Development Department concerned must be produced stating that no other fee concession is being availed by the candidate.

(b) Visually Challenged candidates are exempted from payment of all type of special fee and examination fee. They have to submit attested copy of Medical Certificate to prove their claim.

(c) OBC Students and additional PGdegree candidates are not eligible for fee concession.

- Self attested copy of SSLC/Equivalent for proof of Age and Date Of Birth.
- Self attested copy of AADHAAR/ PAN Card/ Voter ID card (which is provided at the time of sign up )
- Self addressed ( strictly as mentioned in the Column for communication address in the application ) envelope of Size 30 cm. x 25 cm ( without stamp ).
- Those who are eligible for mark relaxation on the basis of caste should submit necessary certificates to prove caste / community.
